
Activation Nature Park Steinwald DLFF-119 02.may 2010

A group of members from the DARC-Ortsverband Stiftland, DOK: U23 made their second DLFF-activation at may, 02 2010.



This time we decided to activate Nature Park Steinwald DLFF-119. Location was in Herzogöd about 730meters asl.

We were using two operating-positions, one in a wooden house directly at the



location where also our 433Mhz repeater is working, second position was in a mobile-trailer just twenty meters away. Starting at 0730 UTC with the first QSO with UA9SGQ the begin was very slowly. 20 Meters was in bad shape. On 40 Meters we had extreme problems to get a clean working frequency at all because several contests made it very difficult. Nearly 90 minutes in our working period where absolutely for nothing. No conditions anywhere. So the best band again was 40 Meters where we made approximately 60 percent of all our contacts. Final QSO was exactly 1300 utc with OH6GZ. Thanks to all callers. Log upload will be done in a few days. Special QSL-cards will follow after new design ready and print is done. Altoghere 465 QSOs were made. 73, 44, Team DA0CW/p
