Nature-Reserve Fichtelseemoor DLFF-0289



My fourth activity from DLFF-0289 was again a successful one. This time propagations much better than the days before.

Had also excellent short-skip openings on that day, so extended my time at location a bit.

Due to a construction-site on the tour left some time and so my first contact was on 1723 UTC with SQ7CGN.

Met also my teammate of our radio-club Peter DJ2OS/p, who was active from DLFF-0133 and also did two castle activities.

First hour on 40 meters was not so well, but then moved to 10, later 20 meters where excellent short-skip propagations opened. Since longer time the first time 20 meters produced more contacts than 40 meters. Mode mix was 54 CW vs. 197 SSB, so altogether 251 QSO with 237 unique stations out of 36 countries.

Top 5 went to: 1. Germany (61) 2. Italy (34) 3. Poland (25) 4. France (15) 5. Netherlands (14)

Made the last contact with DJ9UN at 1954 UTC before I started for the hometrip.

After the activities in 2015, 2016, 2020 and this new one, the reference shows a total of 802 contacts with 681 unique hunters. Thanks for calling in and cuagn soon.
