

## 01.03.2021 DQ11WCA

## NSG Waldsteingipfel DLFF-0559 Burgruine Rotes Schloss DL-03141





Almost same experience like one year ago. Came a bit late out of work and had big traffic on the road, so I was late in the air at 1528 UTC with Karl DL1JKK as first station in the log. His signal was very weak and also during the rest of the operation, conditions to whole germany very poor. As only band 40 meter was usable. After first 30 minutes had to switch to CW as almost no interest any more in phone and heavy QRM from broadcast-stations. When coming back into the SSB-area further 30 minutes later, found an almost clear spot around 7.145 and continoued there until the

end at 1714 with M7KGW as last station. Sun was now totally down and quickly had to repack.

Was dreaming that night if I really had the backup-battery with me, however a secure-view next morning showed me that everything was ok.

In total 190 contacts were made with 185 unique stations. 43 in CW and 147 in SSB.

Got 32 countries in the log. Nr. 1 Italy (46), 2. England (18), 3. Belgium and France (13), 4. Poland (12), 5. Germany (10).
